

**ST. ANDREW'S UNITED CHURCH**  
**FOOTHILLS ART CLUB COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**  
**MAIN FLOOR HALL – WEDNESDAY EVENINGS**  
**(as at September 7, 2021)**

- Foothills Art Club must arrange for a “Leader” who will be responsible to ensure protocols are followed.
- If you are not feeling well, you must stay home.
- Enter at the East Entrance. (The East Entrance shall be the only entry and exit point and the Leader must ensure that the East Entrance Door is locked when leaving).
- **Masks are mandatory.**
- Only participants of the rental activity will be allowed entry to St. Andrew's, and no additional family members can accompany any of the participants inside the building.
- There will not be any outside instructors or demonstrations until further notice.
- Maintain a register of those in attendance in the event that tracing is required.
- Outer clothing (sweaters, coats, jackets) must be kept in the Main Floor Hall as the coat hangers will not be available for use until further notice.
- No lingering in the East Entrance foyer.
- Social Distance as much as reasonably possible.
- East Entrance washroom will be open.
- Other than the East Entrance, East Entrance bathroom and Main Floor Hall, Participants are not to enter any other areas of the Church.
- The kitchen can be accessed for water for a kettle and water dishes only.
- Participants must bring their own refreshments, (no food), and any and all garbage must be taken out by Foothills Art Club Participants when leaving the Church.
- Foothills Art Club is responsible to clean and sanitize all touch points before leaving the facility.
- Tables are to be left up and chairs stacked until further notice.
- A cleaning log will be provided in the Main Floor Hall. The Leader will be responsible to sign off on the cleaning log prior to leaving the building which will indicate the group name, date, time and signature.
- Until further notice, no fall shows, potlucks, or wrap up gatherings.
- As the pandemic continues to evolve, and with the ongoing concern of new variants and rising cases, the AHS and SAUC protocols are subject to change.
- Should any of the Foothills Art Club Participants test positive for COVID-19, Shari Pusch is to be notified immediately (403-861-5049 or [shari@cascorp.ca](mailto:shari@cascorp.ca)), and the rental arrangement will be suspended to accommodate a thorough clean of the Main Floor Hall, and a decision will be made at that time whether the premises will continue to be available.
